The proposed 2023 budget will have a property tax decrease of -\$68.16 (-11.00%) for a 2022 taxable property value of \$100,000.00 compared to a 2021 taxable property value of \$100,000.

The increase base pay for eligible County Employees and Elected Officials will be a 6.0% cost of living increase to base pay in addition to a longevity schedule of \$10.40-\$50.27 per month.
