

ORDER ADOPTING TAX RATE

After notice and hearing, the following motion was offered by Commissioner Davis seconded by Commissioner Vivian;

“I move that the property tax rate be increase by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.674805, which is effectivly a 3.05% increase in the tax rate above the effective tax rate.

Maintenance and Operation (M&O) tax rate of \$0.606969 per \$100 valuation and Interest and Sinking (I&S) tax rate of \$0.067836 per \$100 valuation capped at \$0.80 per \$100 valuation.

Maintenance of Public Roads tax rate of \$0.00 per \$100 valuation capped at \$0.15 per \$100 valuation.

Farm to Market Road or Flood Control tax rate of \$0.00 per \$100 valuation capped at \$0.30 per \$100 valuation.”

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE PROPERTY TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR’S TAX RATE.

THE ADOPTED M&O TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE LOWERED BY 2.54% AND WILL LOWER TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$15.79.

THE ADOPTED TOTAL TAX RATE WILL DECREASE BY 2.87% AND LOWER TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS (M&O) AND INTEREST AND SINKING (I&S) ON A \$100,000 HOME BY \$19.91 COMPARED TO LAST YEAR’S TAX RATE.
