

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
DECEMBER 28, 2020 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; James Clawson, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Ross Davis, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk

- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST REGULAR MEETING.** Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to approve the minutes from the December 14, 2020 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Davis seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

12. PAY BILLS.


Commissioner Clawson entered a motion to pay the bills as presented by the Auditor.


Judge Spurgin presented a plaque of appreciation to James Clawson, Ross Davis and Amber Thompson for their service to Jones County.

ADJOURN


Commissioner Clawson entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Davis seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

Commissioner Precinct 1




Commissioner Precinct 2
