WHERE AS, at an election held in Jones County, Texas, on the 2nd day of October, 1909, to determine whether horses, mules, Jacks, Jinnets and cattle shall be permitted to run at large in said County, there were cast at said election 1077 votes, of which number 789 votes were cast "For the Stock Law", and 288 votes were cast "Against the Stock Law".

I, Jas. P. Stinson, County Judge of said Jones County, Texas, to hereby declare that the proposition "For the Stock Law", was sustained by a majority of the qualified fee holders voting at said election, and that after the expiration fo thirty days from the issuance of this proclamation it shall be unlawful to permit to run at large any horses, mules, jacks, jinnets and cattle, within the limits of said Jones County, Texas.
