**DISASTER DECLARATION**

WHEREAS, the COUNTY OF JONES, since the 31st day, of May, 2021, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from HEAVY RAINS and FLOODING,

WHEREAS, the COUNTY JUDGE has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED THAT THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUE ON JUNE 3rd BE EXTENDED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF JONES COUNTY.

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for JONES COUNTY pursuant to §418.108(a) of the *Texas Government Code*.

Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the *Texas Government Code*, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of time necessary or discontinued by the COMMISSIONERS COURT of JONES COUNTY.

Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the COUNTY CLERK.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the *Texas Government Code*, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the COUNTY emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
