- APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST REGULAR MEETING. Commissioner Vivian entered a
  motion to approve the minutes of the August 10, 2020 regular meeting as presented.
  Commissioner Davis seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
- 2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON DISASTER DECLARATION AND ALL ITEMS RELATED REGARDING FEMA, TDA AND TDEM FORMS AND REQUIREMENTS. No action was taken by the Commissioners Court.
- 3. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON ORDER OF GENERAL ELECTION. Commissioner Davis entered a motion to Order the November 3, 2020 General Election. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit A.
