

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT  
REGULAR MEETING  
MARCH 22, 2021 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Todd McWilliams, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk

- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST REGULAR MEETING.** Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to approve the minutes from the March 8, 2021 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
- 2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON PURCHASE OF LOTS 7-12 BLK 93 HAMLIN TOWNSITE HAMLIN JONES COUNTY BY PRECINCT 1.** Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to submit a bid in the amount of \$1 for the purchase of Lots 7-12 Block 93 Hamlin Townsite Addition by Precinct 1. Judge Spurgin entered a motion to amend the order continuing a declaration of local state of disaster for Covid-19 to remove mask requirement in County owned buildings but allowing each department head to make mask requirements for their office; masks will be required in all courtroom settings including, County Court, District Court and Justice of the Peace Court in accordance with the Covid-19 operating plan for the Jones and Shackelford Counties Judiciary; to reopen all restrooms throughout the Courthouse; to reopen all four entrances on the first floor; Covid-19 prevention protocol including social distancing, hand washing, and the use of hand sanitizer along with the use of face coverings are encouraged; and to extend the order through 11:59 PM on April 26, 2021. Commissioners Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit B.


Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner McWilliams seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.


