

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 25, 2021 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Todd McWilliams, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk.

- 1. APPROVE MINUTES OF LAST REGULAR MEETING.** Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the minutes from the October 12, 2021 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner McWilliams seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
- 2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON A BID SUBMITTED BY DONALD MAYS FOR THE PURCHASE OF (R24766), BEING LOT 6, BLOCK 89, ORIGINAL TOWN OF STAMFORD, JONES COUNTY, TEXAS; BEING THAT PROPERTY MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN A WARRANTY DEED RECORDED IN VOLUME 685, PAGE 418 OF THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF JONES COUNTY, TEXAS. THE BID AMOUNT IS \$310.00. COURT COST HAS BEEN WAIVED.** Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve a bid in the amount of \$310.00 submitted by Donald Mays for the purchase of R24766. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION TO AUTHORIZE LINE ITEM TRANSFER FOR SALARY FOR TRAINING IN EXTENSION OFFICE.** Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to authorize a line item transfer for training in the Extension Office. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

15. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON INMATE PHONE CONTRACT AMENDMENT.

Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the inmate phone contract amendment to charge a flat \$0.21 per minute for inmate telephone services. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit E.

18. AMEND BUDGET AND APPROVE LINE ITEM TRANSFERS.




19. PAY BILLS.


Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to pay the bills as presented by the Auditor. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.


ADJOURN

Commissioner McWilliams entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.



County Judge
