

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
APRIL 27, 2026 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Danny Collett, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk.

1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.

Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the minutes from the April 13, 2026 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON A BID SUBMITTED BY ANGELICA MARIN FOR THE PURCHASE OF (R11447), BEING THE N/2 OF LOT 1, BLOCK 18, ORIGINAL TOWN OF ANSON, JONES COUNTY, TEXAS; BEING THAT PROPERTY MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN A WARRANTY DEED RECORDED IN VOLUME 282, PAGE 478 IN THE DEED RECORDS OF JONES COUNTY, TEXAS. THE BID AMOUNT IS \$10,000.00.

Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to restrict pass thru traffic on CR 126 from St Hwy 83 to FM 1835, CR 136 from St Hwy 83 to FM 1835, CR 97 from CR 126 to FM 1835, CR 145 from CR 132 to St Hwy 92, CR 213 from Haskell County Line to FM 142, CR 223 from FM 600 to St Hwy 6, CR 214 from FM 600 to Shackelford County Line, CR 206 from St Hwy 6 to FM 704, CR 250 from St Hwy 6 to Shackelford County Line, CR 241 from CR 210 to St Hwy 6. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit D.


22. PAY BILLS.


Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to pay the bills as presented by the Auditor. Commissioner Spraberry seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

ADJOURN


Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Collett seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
