

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
MAY 26, 2026 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Danny Collett, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4. LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk was absent.

1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.

Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the minutes of the May 11, 2026 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON A BID SUBMITTED BY CODY ROBERTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF R24720, WINKLES LUEDERS BLOCK 2, LOTS 10-12. THE BID AMOUNT IS \$2410.00. COURT COSTS ARE \$837.00.

29. PAY BILLS.


Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to pay the bills as presented by the Auditor. Commissioner Spraberry seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.


The Extension Office submitted an office agenda for the Court to review. See Exhibit L.


Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.



County Judge




Commissioner Precinct 2




Commissioner Precinct 4
