

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
JUNE 8, 2026 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Danny Collett, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk.

1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.

Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the minutes of May 26, 2026 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON TAC HEALTH INSURANCE RENEWAL BY ROBERT MILLS. Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to approve the Texas Association of Counties health insurance renewal through Blue Cross Blue Shield with a 6.5% increase presented by Robert Mills. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit A

28. AMEND BUDGET AND APPROVE LINE-ITEM TRANSFERS.




Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Spraberry seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.




County Judge




Commissioner Precinct 1




Commissioner Precinct 2
