

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
JUNE 22, 2026 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Danny Collett, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk.

1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.

Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the minutes of the June 8, 2026 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

2. DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION ON 2025 AUDIT BY JAMES E. RODGERS AND COMPANY.

Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to approve the 2025 audit by James E Rodgers and Company. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit A.

Commissioner Collett seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye. See Exhibit I.

Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to approve the purchase of 16 pollbooks from Election Systems and Software in the amount of \$20,250.00 paid with ARPA funds. 33. PAY BILLS.

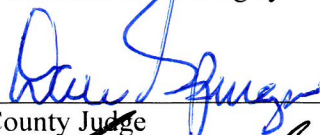
Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to pay the bills as presented by the Auditor. Commissioner Collett seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

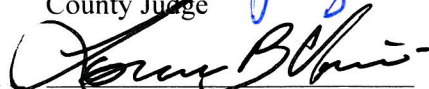

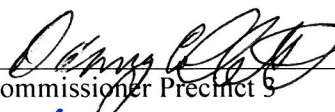
Commissioner Spraberry entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Vivian seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.
