

**JONES COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
REGULAR MEETING
MARCH 28, 2022 - 9:00 AM**

The Commissioner's Court of Jones County, Texas, met this day in regular session with the following members present: Dale Spurgin, County Judge, presiding; Roy Spalding, Commissioner Precinct 1; Lonnie Vivian, Commissioner Precinct 2; Todd McWilliams, Commissioner Precinct 3; Joel Spraberry, Commissioner Precinct 4; and LeeAnn Jennings, Jones County Clerk.

1. APPROVE MINUTES OF THE LAST REGULAR MEETING.

Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to approve the minutes from the March 14, 2022 regular meeting as presented. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

19. PAY BILLS.


Commissioner Vivian entered a motion to pay the bills as presented by the Auditor. Commissioner Spalding seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.

DISCUSSION ITEM


Sandra Villanueva submitted a request to speak form. See Exhibit E.

Commissioner Spalding entered a motion to adjourn. Commissioner McWilliams seconded the motion with all other Commissioners voting aye.



County Judge
